The “Little” hospice is an eight bed residential hospice located in the heart of Edina, near Southdale. This large double bungalow has been designed to accommodate eight hospice patients on a single level, each in private rooms. Each room has its own cable television, radio and telephone. Also, flexible menus, eating schedules, 24-hour visitation for families, children, friends and pets are provided.

Licensed with the State of Minnesota as a hospice and supervised living facility, the “Little” hospice offers a home-like atmosphere for the patient and his/her family. Families can stay overnight in one of several upstairs living areas, or “camp out” in their loved one’s room. A large family room downstairs offers opportunity for privacy and relaxation, as well as a recreation area complete with pool table. A most reverent and inspiring non-denominational meditation room is also provided.

“Little” hospice offers 24-hour, trained hospice caregivers and volunteers working together with patients and their families to ensure that the quality of the patient’s remaining life will be the finest possible. We continually enjoy comments from patients and families about the safe, compassionate

and loving environment found at the “Little” hospice.
